HEIFER FUTURITY RULES

Consignment Rules:

1. Consignments are limited to two animals per producer. Heifers must be born between January 1, 2017 – April 30, 2017.
2. All breeds, including cross breeds are eligible for futurities.
3. All heifers must be weaned, dehorned, have all vaccinations (including Bangs) and be halter broke.
4. Nominations close on **Friday, Sept. 1st, 2017**. Nomination fee is \$75.00 per animal. The commission is \$75.00 entry fee or 10% of the gross sale price, whichever is greater. All commission fees are applied to the premiums.
5. Payment to sellers will be made within **15 working days of sale date**.
6. All Futurity nominations will abide by the Open Class Livestock Rules in the Jackson County Exhibitors Entry Book.
7. All animals nominated must have been bred and raised by consignor.
8. All animals purchased in Futurity sales must be shown in the 2018 Futurity Show to be eligible for Futurity money.
9. Heifers selling as Registered must send a copy of the papers with entry. Papers must be in office at sale date if registered. If we do not have the ORIGINAL papers, we will not sell heifer as registered, she will be sold as commercial. Transfer fee will be deducted.
10. ALL HEIFERS WILL BE CHECKED IN FRIDAY, September 15th, 2017 between 8:00 am -2:00 pm at the Jackson County Expo. Central Point, OR.
11. All animals sifted out can leave at the conclusion of the heifer sale Saturday night.
12. The sifting committee reserves the right to sift any heifer for defects of conformation, quality or disposition.

CONSIGNMENT FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE

Purchase Rules:

1. Purchaser must not be over 21 years old by January 1, 2017.
2. Open to residents of Jackson, Josephine, Klamath and other Counties of interest.
3. All purchases must be made in the name of the junior exhibitor.
4. All animals purchased at the 2016 sale must be exhibited in the 2017 show in order to be eligible for Futurity money.
5. The 2018 Show will be open to heifers owned and shown by the original purchaser only.
6. Purchase must be paid for immediately after auction, Cash, Check or Cashier Checks.
7. Jackson County Expo or Harvest Fair Committee makes no representation regarding livestock being sold and does not provide any warranties. All sales are AS IS and ALL SALES ARE FINAL.
