The corporate identity of BoomFest is trademarked and may not be reproduced or employed in any manner without the express written consent of BoomFest or its designate. When permission to reproduce the identity is extended, it remains contingent upon implementation of the identity in a manner consistent with these guidelines.

## Corporate Typography

BoomFest identity relies on clean and readable typography. The following font options should be used when creating content or materials for BoomFest:

#### Sans-Serif

- Primary Neutraface Text
- Alternative Helvetica, Myriad or Arial

#### Serif

- **Primary** Adobe Garamond Pro
- Alternative Georgia or Adobe Caslon

## Unacceptable Logo Use

These are some of the most common misuses and do not represent all possible cases of unacceptable logo usage. DO NOT alter or distort the logo artwork in any way. DO NOT incorporate the logo into any other artwork or design. The logo is intended to stand alone.





DO NOT angle the logo



DO NOT use an incompatible background

DO NOT stroke the logo







DO NOT distort in any way



DO NOT place on a "busy" background



DO NOT place text too close to the logo



DO NOT add any effects to the logo



DO NOT use the logo smaller than 3/4" in height

# File Type Usage

The BoomFest logo is available in EPS, PDF or PNG file types. It is important to use the correct file type for the application. Follow the guidelines below in order to select the correct file type to use:

- **EPS** files are used mainly for professional purposes and can be scaled to any size without losing original image quality.
- PDF files are recognized by most software and can be scaled to any size without losing original image quality.
- PNG files are to be used for web purposes because of the small file size and transparent background. DO NOT scale PNG files larger than the original file size.
