What network settings do I need to use?

Why won't my Email/Virtual Private Network/Internet messenger software work?

For security reasons, the only service allowed over Hunter's wireless is web browsing. You may send email through a webmail provider like Gmail, Hotmail, or Yahoo. If you require VPN access, Hunter can accommodate your client software at cost (please call for pricing).

What areas of the Expo are covered by Hunter's wireless?

The interior of the Seven Feathers Event Center, Padgham Pavilion, Mace Watchable Wildlife Building, and the Bi-Mart Amphitheater ,(dependent on weather). Service can be made available in other areas, subject to fee. Please contact Hunter for more information.
