MEDFORD, OREGON — Business Oregon and the Jackson County Emergency Operations Center (EOC) is distributing another allotment of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to Jackson County Businesses of all sizes.

The distribution center has been set up at the Jackson County Expo; 1 Peninger Road, Central Point, Oregon 97502.

The center will be open June 22 -June 24 from 7:30 am- 10:30 am each day.

Please enter at Gate 3 and follow signs to drive through the event center to get your needed supplies.

“All businesses are gearing up to open full speed and Business Oregon wants to help by providing these critical supplies. All PPE is free of charge to Oregon based businesses.,” noted Helen Funk, Jackson County Emergency Operations Center, “We are looking forward to getting back to our normal operations safely.”
